Religious Studies will be a means of celebrating the living reality of the presence of the Divine and we will seek to help each student not only to discover but to use their God-given gifts.

For those students not studying A Level Religious Studies, there is a requirement to follow General RE.

The RE Department have recently developed modules that received Diocesan approval and accreditation from the National Open College Network, with students now receiving either Level 2 or Level 3 qualifications.

The course will enable learners to reflect theologically on their experience of school, the values of wider curriculum and contemporary culture.

Study will include participation in at least one day's reflection each year

All Year 12 and 13 students are timetabled for weekly Religious Studies. Teaching is arranged round a carousel system which facilitates variety in the learning experience and enables students to work with staff with particular subject expertise within Religious Education.
