Religious Studies will be a means of celebrating the living reality of the presence of the Divine and we will seek to help each student not only to discover but to use their God-given gifts.

For those students not sitting A/S or A Level Religious Studies, there is an Archdiocesan requirement for the provision of 'Core RE'.

The Department have recently developed modules that received Diocesan approval.

Students following a Core course will be allocated to one of five teachers.

In Year 12 pupils will plan and deliver a charity event to Year 7 and create a portfolio of evidence to be assessed.

In Year 13 pupils will study 3 options from the units offered.

All Year 12 and 13 students are timetabled for one Core Religious Education lesson per week. There is no formal coursework or examination, and successful completion of the course is based on internal assessment of work. Lesson attendance is compulsory and essential in order for sufficient work to be completed to allow students to pass the course.

The content of the course

has been specifically designed to be of maximum interest and relevance to our students, as well as drawing on the specific expertise of our five specialist members of the Department.
