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This year, we also sent 200 of the cards (with messages in English and Arabic) to Holy Family Parish in Gaza in the Holy Land. The parish school has 1,250 pupils so it's not too dissimilar in size to St. Julie's. Y7-10 all contributed to this.

Gaza is one of the most densely populated areas in the world. There are 5,000 Christians among a million Muslims. 50% of the population are under 15. It's also a very troubled place so it was good to show our solidarity with our brothers and sisters out there in the land where Jesus himself once walked all those years ago!
