### Age

The school roll includes children from age 11 (Year 7) to age 18 (Year 13). There are **841** in year groups 7-11 and **143** in year groups 12-13.

### Disability

There are **96** pupils with disabilities (Spring Census 2017). Disabilities include physical, hearing and visual impairment, autistic spectrum disorders and specific learning difficulties. Physical disabilities include Cerebral Palsy, Muscular dystrophy, arthritis and Spina Bifida. The school is nearly fully accessible. The curriculum and extra-curricular activities are accessible to all students with disabilities.

The attainment of all groups as measured by capped and Total Points Score are in line with or above the National Average, however the attainment of students designated as White was Sig + for Capped total points scores GCSE only and for Total points score GCSE only.

**FSM**

**There are 14.2% students eligible for FSM. The Ever6 figure is 22.7%.**

**20 students aged 16-19 qualified for a Discretionary Bursary, 2 students were awarded a Vulnerable Group Bursary.**

**Looked After Children**
