RE: Sixth Form Success

We are delighted to inform you that the latest Performance Tables for summer 2015 examinations, published by the Department for Education, show St Julie's Catholic High School to be the number 4 ranked school/college in the city for student progress on A Level courses and the number 5 ranked school/college in the city for progress on vocational courses, including Level 3 BTEC qualifications. This is out of forty providers in the Liverpool region.

We are the only school/college in the city to be ranked in the top 5 for both measures.

We are now ranked in the top 20% of post-16 providers in North West of England and the top 25% nationally for academic progress.

In addition to this, analysis of university applications made by our Year 13 cohort in 2015 shows that the percentage of applicants from St Julie's who were accepted onto a university course for September 2015 was 80.3%, which is significantly higher than the acceptance rate nationally of 74%. Over 90% of successful applicants from St Julie's secured their place through the main UCAS scheme, without needing to go through the 'Clearing' process on results day, compared to only 83% nationally.
