I am writing to inform you of arrangements for A Level Results Days for summer examinations 2014 on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> August.

## A Level

- A Level Results will be available between 9.00 am and 11.00am in the Cuvily Dining Room.
- Once students have collected their results, they should complete a **Destination Form** and return this to the staff manning the doors of the Cuvily Dining Room
- Students requiring further UCAS support (e.g. with regard to the 'Clearing' process) should speak to either Mr Willis (if before 10.30) or Mrs Jones who will be available in the Cuvily Dining Room.
- Our Careers Advisor and Learning Mentor, Kevin Fay, will also be present in the Cuvily Dining Room to offer impartial advice and guidance.

## A/S Level

- AS Level results will be available **between 10.30am and 12.00am** in the **Cuvily Dining Room.**
- Students collecting A/S results are asked not to arrive in school before 10.30am, as they will not be seen ahead of current Year 13 leavers making final UCAS decisions.
- Once students have collected their results, they should complete a **Destination Form** and return this to the staff manning the doors of the Cuvily Dining Room
- It is important that students then go to the **Picardy Dining** Room for enrolment into Year 13. They will complete their **Option Form** in consultation with a member of staff and take it to Mr Brooks.
- Students who have not met entry requirements for Year 13 will be directed to either Mrs McCourt or Mr Willis to discuss their options.
- Each student will be provided with information in preparation for final coursing on Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> September. Students who have met the relevant progression criteria as previously published will now have a confirmed place in Year 13 and should report in full Sixth Form uniform to the Picardy Dining Room between 11am and 1 pm on Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> September for final coursing.


