

# REVISION IDEAS

## CHIPS

This strategy can be used a number of ways;


1. Write and define key words, by the end you have created a portion of topic 'chips'
2. Explore various past paper questions and write these on their chips to practice at home
3. Write key words on one portion of chips and the definitions on another portion. This could then be used as a match up game until all the key words have been defined.



## FLASHCARDS

Flashcards are for testing not summarising! Use flashcards as a quick way of testing what you know.

1. On the front of the card, write a key term or question
2. On the back of the card, answer that question or write the definition for the term
3. Try to guess the answer/definition on the front before checking the answer on the back.



A simple way of implementing this tip is to sort your flashcards as you revise with them.

After you answer a flashcard, put it into one of three piles:

- I have no clue about this
- I'm not too sure about this
- I really know this
