St Julie's Catholic High School

- 1. The name of the school is St Julie's Catholic High School.
- 2. The school was founded by the Congregation of the Sisters of Notre Dame. The school is to be conducted as a Catholic School in accordance with canon law and teachings of the Roman Catholic Church and in accordance with the Trust Deed of the Sisters of Notre Dame and the spirit and charism of St Julie Billiart, the Foundress of the Congregation
 - (a) religious education is to be in accordance with the teachings, doctrines, discipline and general and particular norms of the Catholic Church;
 - (b) religious worship is to be in accordance with the rites, practices, discipline and liturgical norms of the Catholic Church;
 - (c) the principal aim of the school is to put into practice that saying of St Julie Billiart, the foundress of Notre Dame, "Let them be taught what is necessary for life". This calls for the education of the whole person: spiritual, moral, intellectual and physical.

and at all times the school is to serve as a witness to the Catholic faith in Our Lord Jesus Christ.

- 3. The school is a voluntary aided school in the trusteeship of the Sisters of Notre Dame.
- 4. The name of the governing body is "The Governing Body of St Julie's Catholic High School"
- 5. The governing body shall consist of:
 - (a) two parent governors;
 - (b) one local authority governor;
 - (c) the headteacher;
 - (d) one staff governor;
 - (e) seven foundation governors.
- 6. Total number of governors is twelve.

- 7. Foundation governors are appointed and may be removed by the Trustees; Sisters of Notre Dame (or any other person for the time being exercising the powers of the Trustees).
 - 8. The term of office for each category of governor, other than Foundation Governors, shall be four years from the date of appointment.

The term of office for Foundation Governors shall be between one and four years as determined by the Trustees at the time of appointment and notified to the Clerk.

- 9. This Instrument of Government comes into effect on 02 July 2025.
- 10. This Instrument of Government made by order of Liverpool Local Authority on 03 July 2025.
- 11. A copy of this Instrument of Government must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and any head teacher if not a governor).
