Age

The school roll includes children from age 11 (Year 7) to age 18 (Year 13). There are 886 in year groups 7-11 and 154 in year groups 12-13.

Disability

There are 78 pupils with disabilities. Disabilities include physical / medical conditions, hearing and visual impairment, Autistic Spectrum Disorder and Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder. Physical disabilities include Cerebral Palsy, Muscular Dystrophy, Arthritis and Spina Bifida. The school is nearly fully accessible. The curriculum and extra- curricular activities are accessible to all students with disabilities.
