Re: A-Level taster sessions

Your child is now in Year 11 and will soon be making decisions on the next stage of their education. A lot of students consider A Levels at this stage and our application process will begin in early 2022. This tends to be the same as other 6th forms and colleges across the city.

It can be a difficult and stressful time for your child, so we have a transition programme in place to support this. We will begin by offering short taster sessions of the A level subjects we offer in St Julie's presently. These are 30-minute sessions to show what the subject is like at A Level and gives the opportunity to ask the teacher questions about the course.

I have put a timetable together and it is below. Your child can attend the taster sessions of the subjects they are interested in studying at A Level. All sessions take place from 3:30pm in the venue shown on the table.

I will put the timetable on the website, and it may change if other subjects become available. Staff are also available outside of these times to speak about their subjects at A level. I will update students regularly in school about any additions to this timetable.
